State Legislation Filed to Prohibit Sanctuary Cities in Texas by Creating "Uniform" Standard for Texas Law Enforcement

Austin, Texas ~ On Wednesday, State Senator Tommy Williams (R-The Woodlands) and State Representative Burt Solomons (R-Carrollton) filed companion bills (SB11 and HB 12) to prohibit sanctuary policies which either directly or indirectly harbor illegal immigrants in Texas cities.

In a joint statement released by Williams, and Solomons, the legislators said: "The purpose of this legislation is to establish a uniform and consistent standard for all Texas law enforcement when it comes to enforcing federal immigration laws."
